- Manage IT infrastructure, including servers, computers, and software licences.
- Implement cybersecurity measures to protect the organisation's data and systems.

- Bachelor's degree in computer science, information technology, or a related field.
- Previous experience in website management and IT support.
- Proficiency in web content management systems (WordPress)
- Knowledge of IT infrastructure and cybersecurity best practices.
- Strong troubleshooting and problem-solving skills.

Working Conditions
